Picked up some new additions to the 50th scale collection over the last couple weeks. First to arrive was the First Gear Peterbilt 367 tractor with Talbert lowbed trailer. The trailer is the real star here, with removeable gooseneck, working ramps and outriggers (see pic for explanation). Comes with wide load signs, beacon lights on tractor and trailer and a tool to help open the outriggers.



The tractor has opening doors and tilting hood, but needed chains, binders and some decal work...
