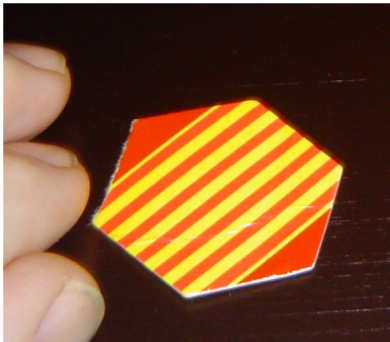


This reminds me

It does sort of look like the wings etc on the Chitty but I think you have something else in mind. Looks like a box top or end.

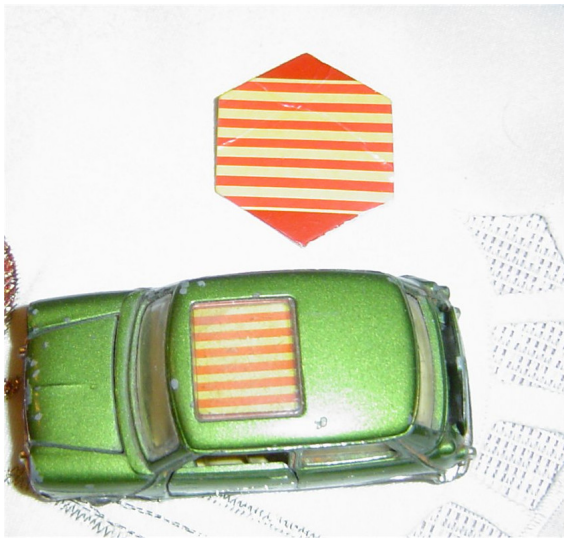
