The paint on the Atlas/De Agostini replicas is that strong that it took 10 days in a thinner bath to make the paint soft so I could remove the paint with a copper wire brush. That was a first for me, because the paint normally used by Atlas was quicker to remove. The models are waiting for their first coat of primer, that will happen over the coming weekend
