Norev started making 1:64ish cars I believe in the seventees and ended in the eighties. They used some Schuco 1:66 casts as well, possibly after Schuco got into financial trouble, also in the seventees? Afterwards they also used some casts from Chinese manufacturers.

Around 2000 or so, Norev started making cars in the same kind of scale, slightly bigger, for manufacturers, the first being Renault. As far as I can make out, one of the first casts was a Renault Kangoo. Since then, they made cars for the major French car manufacturers, later followed by Mercedes-Benz (but this deal seems to have ended already), Mini, Volkswagen, Opel and Lancia, though they have made cars of many other car manufacturers too.

As their scope has grown so big, might it be a good idea to discuss these here? I believe the webmaster of www.mjrttrv.nl is one of the bigger collectors of this brand and has published some books about the subject and he might be able to help?
